of use of District facilities. They shall assure that persons or organizations using District property are charged such fees as are authorized by law. Public use of District property shall not interfere with scheduled instructional programs, other scheduled activities of the District on behalf of employees or students, or other previously authorized civic center activities.

No group or organization may use District property to unlawfully discriminate on the basis of race, color, ancestry, national origin, ethnic group identification, religion, age, gender, marital status, domestic partner status, sexual orientation, disability or AIDS/HIV status, medical conditions, gender identity, or status as a Vietnam Era veteran. These categories specifically include status as a lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender or questioning person or on any basis prohibited by law.

Use of the District's civic centers will be only for the purposes described by the California Legislature in Education Code Section 82537(a). These purposes include use by associations "formed for recreational, educational, political, economic, artistic, or moral
